Morning Church!

Sixty-two years ago this month, JFK delivered his Inaugural Address. Historians rank it as one of the best ever. First, JFK hoped his speech would inspire Americans to become fully invested in his vision. Then, Kennedy reminded the global community that personal sacrifice and commitment would be required of every citizen as the Cold War intensified and the emergent Nuclear Age would challenge international peace and stability.

"...we shall pay any price, bear any burden, meet any hardship, support any friend, oppose any foe to assure the survival and success of liberty."

"Ask not what your country can do for you.
Ask what you can do for your country."

The Sermon on the Mount is Jesus' Inaugural Address. He taught a diverse crowd that covered a vast spectrum of humanity: Gentiles and Jews, religious, non-religious folk, and those rejected by the so called righteous ~ the sinners, prostitutes, tax collectors, and those who are poor. The Sermon on the Mount is Christ's vision for all who strive to follow him.

The Beatitudes are Divine Reversals, gospel values that are the exact opposite of what the culture prizes. No one strives to be poor in spirit, mournful, lowly, vulnerable, hungry, or thirsty. No one desires to be persecuted, judged, slandered or insulted. This goes against every fiber of personal pride and self-aggrandizement.

The Beatitude are the utmost expression of the Divine Reversal. In living a Beatitude life, you become a visible expression of who God is and what God honors and graces.

The crowd who followed Jesus to The Plain, yearned from the encouragement of those who truly understood their suffering and lived esperience. They felt blest in Christ's Beatitudes mirroring their struggles and reminding them of God's saving presence.

Blest are those who ought to have no reason why they are blest! I am always with you ~ in all you experience on your faithjourney.

The Beatitudes are our blessedness ~ despite what the world says. Striving to live the Beatitudes will stretch your heart to live *beyond* the narrowness of the 10 Commandments. Christ's new, life-giving teaching challenges believers to rely and completely trust God. Reflect on this adaptation:

Will you pay any price, bear any burden, meet any hardship, support any friend, oppose any foe to assure the gospel is proclaimed wherever your feet are?

Ask not what Christ can do for you. Ask what you can do for Christ.




