

# 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ July 9, 2023

# Morning Church!

One day, Sister Patrick Maureen, R.S.M., taught our class about Baptism, and the privilege and responsibilities of being a *God*parent. Without missing a beat, I got it. I wanted to be a Godparent more than anything.

My three older siblings are Godparents to my three younger ones. In my naivete, all my mom needed to do is go to the hospital and pick out another baby for me. Arriving home, I began to relentlessly lobby for a new baby. My mom and I had "the talk". I decided to go another route and prayed daily for my parents to change their minds. Two years later, my mom announces at the dinner table, "*I'm pregnant*". With no surprise in my voice, I said, "I know. I've been praying for this for two years."

On Feb. 20, 1960, God entrusted Celeste to our family and to me as my Godchild. *Love at first sight* is an understatement. As soon as I came home from school, I'd gather Celeste in my arms and set her on my knees for the predictable *Peek-a-Boo* and *Here's the Church* reveal games. No matter how many times we'd play, Celeste bursted into a full belly laugh and motion "again". In her face I saw God's grace of presence, joy, goodness, and compassion. Through her, I experienced God's spontaneity and extravagant love. I still do.

This Child of God and Grace looked at life and said, "I'm all in" and she continues to live life fully. We were inseparable for the next five years. This all changed September, 1965. I entered the SSJs and Celeste started kindergarten. In retrospect, I see that God sent Celeste to enhance my spiritual, peripheral vision and remind me God is seen in the childlike, gentle, patient, and kind people.

Celeste renews my heart and eases the yoked weight of my burdens. When she begins a sentence, *"Listen to me"*, I listen, because God speaks through her.

Doesn't God put people in your life to mentor and affirm you? Aren't these childlike ones,  $\sim$  sometimes your pets  $\sim$  the very presence of God revealed to you in mysterious ways? I believe so.

Consider *your image of God*. Is your image of God the exuberant, unbridled joy and curiosity of a child? Or is your image of God one of a distant, harsh, perfectionist judge? Psalm 145 best describes God as gracious, merciful, slow to anger, of great kindness, compassionate, faithful, holy, lifting up the lowly, and raising up those who are bowed down.

God invites you to come and find rest; desires to ease your burdens and giggle out loud with you. This is your God, One who dwells in you, for you, as you. If you believe this, it will change you forever.

> Celeste means *heavenly*, *one who shines like the stars*. She is perfectly named. When we played Peek-a-Boo, I saw God in her face. She is an Answer to Prayer. My *God*child has changed me forever.




do His work. For some people that means preaching like He did, or healing the sick, or being a priest, but for most people it means just doing everything we have to do out of love for God.
